We are excited to announce the opening of (Re)Think Civics - Powered by AT&T.

We're launching this challenge to translate and scale the best local civic engagement efforts. This Civic Engagement playlist challenge is only open for organizations and cities on the LRNG Platform, meaning you have the exclusive opportunity to participate.

LRNG defines playlists as a curated group of Learning Experiences (XP) and resources, stitched together into a compelling mediarich narrative around a common theme. All playlists submitted as part of the (Re)Think Civics challenge will be public and remixable through LRNG's content library. Additionally, organizations can share the playlists as is, or using LRNG's unique remixing feature, they can edit experiences (XPs) within the playlist before publishing the playlist to their audience. A \$10,000 prize purse will be distributed to the first, second and third place winners. \$5,000 will go to the first place winner, \$2,000 to second, and three \$1,000 awards will go to third, fourth and fifth place submissions.

A panel of youth LRNG interns and 2 members of the LRNG team will judge the submissions. Submissions will be accepted through May 24th and winners will be announced in June. All submissions will be judged against this rubric. Criteria includes if the information within the playlist was helpful, if activities were easy to understand, did the playlist unlock an opportunity for future career or college plans, and whether students enjoyed the content.

Submissions may not include materials under copyright or trademark protection or where the Contributor does not have rights to use in these submissions. Final winners will be subject to internal review by LRNG. If the submissions received do not meet minimum requirements, LRNG will extend the challenge into the Fall.
